1. THE STUDENT AND PARENT/GUARDIAN MUST SIGN THE PARKING APPLICATION BEFORE THE STUDENT IS ALLOWED TO PARK A VEHICLE ON SCHOOL GROUNDS. THE ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL WILL REVIEW THE APPLICATION BEFORE A PARKING HANGTAG IS ISSUED. PARKING ON SCHOOL GROUNDS IS A PRIVILEGE RESERVED FOR SENIORS AND JUNIORS ONLY.
2. THE PARKING HANGTAG MUST BE CLEARLY DISPLAYED AT ALL TIMES.
3. THE SENIOR PARKING LOT IS LOCATED PARALLEL TO ROUTE 1. PARKING IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE HUMAN SERVICES LOT ITSELF. THE JUNIOR LOT IS LOCATED ACROSS FROM THE BASEBALL FIELD.
4. STUDENTS MAY NOT ENTER THEIR VEHICLES WHILE SCHOOL IS IN SESSION WITHOUT A PASS FROM THE OFFICE.
5. THE VEHICLE IS PARKED ON SCHOOL PROPERTY AT THE OWNER'S RISK. THE SCHOOL WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE TO THE VEHICLE.
6. STONINGTON HIGH SCHOOL HAS A TRAFFIC PATTERN WHICH WAS CREATED IN CONSULTATION WITH THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENT. IT IS DESIGNED WITH THE MAXIMUM SAFETY IN MIND. TRAFFIC SIGNS CLEARLY INDICATE THE ONE-WAY TRAFFIC PATTERN ON THE HIGH SCHOOL CAMPUS. ALL STUDENTS WHO DRIVE TO SCHOOL MUST FOLLOW THIS TRAFFIC PATTERN. STUDENTS MUST BE EXTREMELY CAUTIOUS WHILE DRIVING ON OR NEAR THE CAMPUS BECAUSE OF THE NUMBER OF PEDESTRIANS IN THE AREA.
7. IF THE NEED ARISES, THE ADMINISTRATION HAS THE RIGHT TO MODIFY RULES AS THE SCHOOL YEAR PROGRESSES.
8. FAILURE TO FOLLOW PARKING GUIDELINES AND/OR UNSAFE OPERATION ON OR NEAR SCHOOL GROUNDS MAY BE GROUNDS FOR LOSS OF PARKING PRIVILEGES. VEHICLES WITHOUT AN SHS PARKING PERMIT WILL RECEIVE A \$25.00 FINE. VEHICLES PARKED ILLEGALLY AND/OR IN VIOLATION OF SCHOOL REGULATIONS WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE.
