

GUIDANCE

Guidance facilities (counseling-educational, vocational, and personal; occupational information; testing and follow-up) are provided for all students attending Stonington High School. Complete records are maintained on each student and are on file in the office. These records contain data necessary for effective counseling and also provide faculty members with a thorough knowledge of every student. Faculty members are urged to consult these cumulative records when needed and to request of the counselors further interpretation of information contained therein. Keys to these files are available with the director of guidance, guidance secretary, and Fine and Applied Arts Interdisciplinary Coordinator.

Classroom teachers can further assist the counselors in the following ways:

1. **Report significant pupil behavior, interests, plans, and aptitudes which the counselor should know about.**
2. Encourage students, particularly those needing specialized help, to make use of counseling services.
3. Cooperate with counselors in the dissemination of occupational and other guidance-related information.

The guidance counselors, in turn, will work closely with faculty members in helping them better understand the students and their individual differences. They will also assist teachers in obtaining, interpreting, and using guidance data.
